

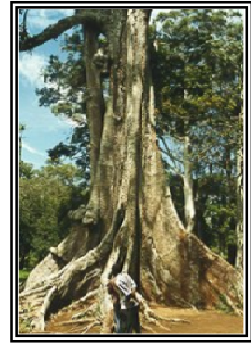
## ***CHIMPANZEE TRACKING AT KIBALE FOREST NATIONAL PARK 3days/2nights***



### **Day 1: Kampala – Kibale Forest Park**

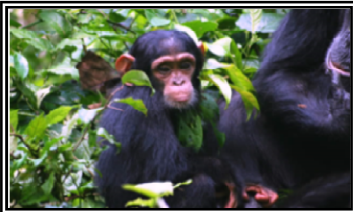


Depart from Kampala after an early breakfast and head to Kibale Forest National Park. Make a stopover at the Nakaima cultural tree “witch tree” in Mubende. Kibale forest is the largest protected block of rain forest. This has the highest number of primates in Africa such as Chimpanzees, Gray Cheeked Mangabay, Red Colobus monkey, Red tailed monkey etc. Arrive in the late afternoon. Approximate driving time is 6 – 7 hours.



### **Day 2: Tracking in Kibale**

After breakfast, enter the forest in search for chimpanzees the experience is quiet exciting and adventurous. Expect to see other species of primates



such as Baboons, Red colobus monkey, Black and white colobus monkey, Grey cheeked mangabey, Red tailed monkey, Birds like sun birds, Turaco, pitas and other bird species, butterfly species etc. return late afternoon for relaxation or an option of visiting Bigodi swamp. Overnight at, the lodge.

### **Day 3: Kibale – Kampala**

After breakfast, before returning to Kampala, visit one of the many crater lakes in the region. Have early lunch in Fort Portal before setting off to Kampala



Rates cost include park entrance fees, game drives, launch cruise, ferry crossing, taxes, all ground transportation in a 4WD vehicle, an English speaking driver/guide, airport pick-up and drop-off
